- Largest humanitarian association specialised in the pharmaceutical sector
- Founded in 1985 to help people who have no access to live-saving medications

Pharmacists without Borders

- Different national associations have different regulations
- German example:
Requirements to get a deployment abroad:
 - 2 weeks of training
 - Undergraduates are eligible as well

Doctors without Borders

General requirements:

- At least two years of relevant professional experience
- Availability for a minimum of 9 to 12 months
- Relevant travel or work
- Experience supervising, managing and training others
- Flexibility and adaptability
- Ability to work and live as a team
- Language skills are a valued asset



MANDATORY DOCUMENTS:

- CV (1-2 pages) (No EUROPASS)
- Motivation letter (1 page)
- Proof of student status/graduation

OPTIONAL DOCUMENTS:

- Recommendation letters
- English certificate
- Diplomas or certificates
- Other language certificates

Selection procedure

How does the pre-selection process work?

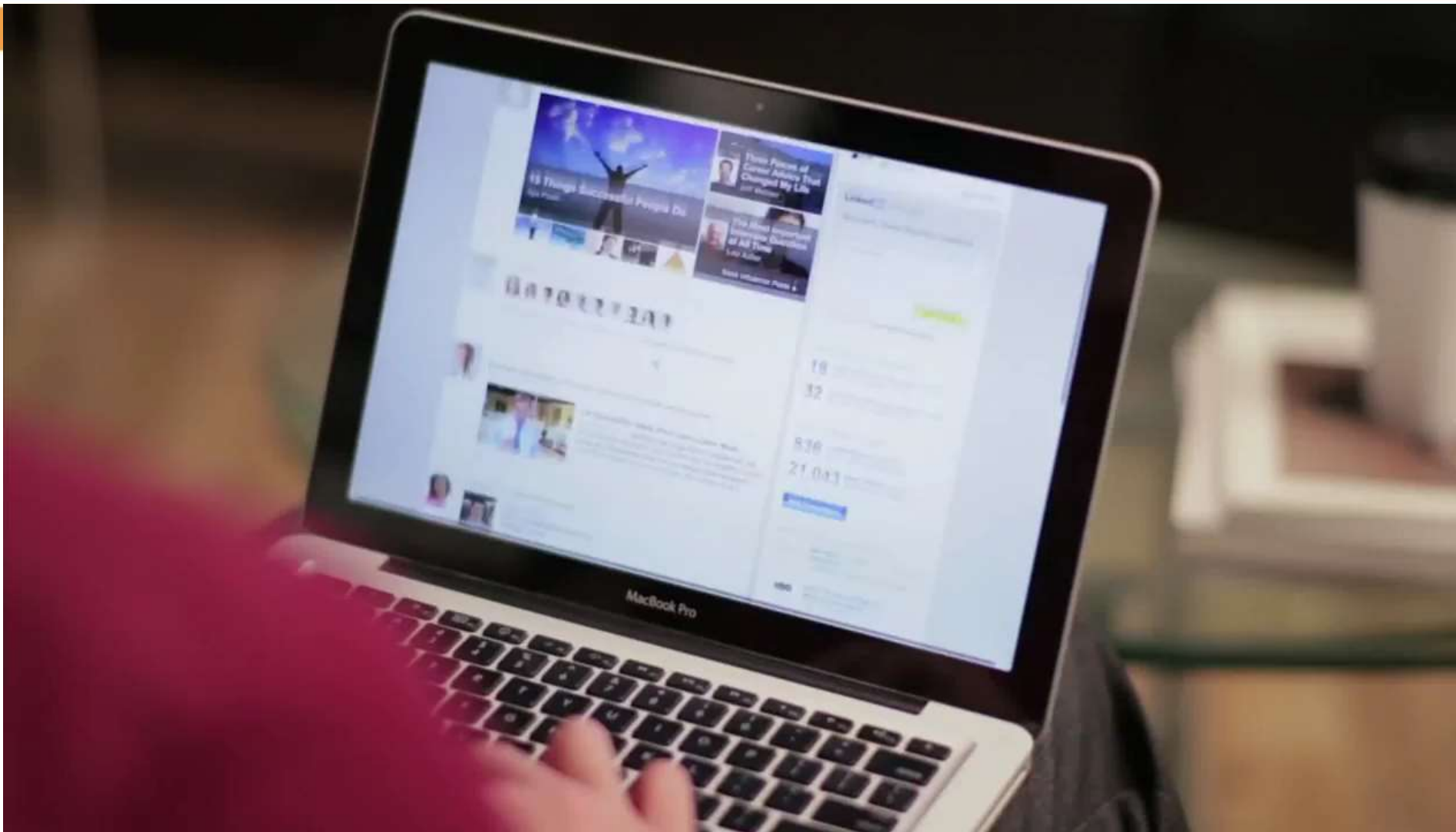
